DETAIL ITINERARY

DAY 1: ARRIVE SIEM REAP AIRPORT – SUNSET TOUR – STAY OVERNIGHT IN SIEM REAP

- Our staff will welcome you in Hanoi airport then to take you to the hotel
- Around 5:00 – 5:30pm, we'll head over to our spot where we'll see the sunset.
- You have the option to either see the sunset at the South Gate of Angkor Thom or the very popular Phnom Bakheng.
- Many guests prefer the South Gate as it is a lot quieter than the large numbers which congregate at Bakheng Mountain.

DAY 2: ANGKOR WAT SYSTEM DAY TOUR - STAY OVERNIGHT IN SIEM REAP

- 8AM : Pick up in hotel lobby then take a tour to see the South Gate of Angkor Thom, Bayon, Bapuon, the Terrace of Elephants and the Leper King.
- Lunch at the local restaurant .In the afternoon, visit the fabulous Angkor Wat complex and watch the picturesque sunset at Phnom Bakheng. Dinner on Guest's account

DAY 3: ANGKOR WAT – TONLE SAP LAKE - FLY TO SAIGON - STAY OVERNIGHT IN SAIGON

- After breakfast, we travel southeast out of Siem Reap to one of the largest and least-visited villages on the Tonle Sap Lake, Kompong Khleang, about 55km from Siem Reap. It's a population of 10,000 all make a living from the fishing industry. We explore the canals (wet season) or streets (dry season) of this incredible town.
- In the wet season, the houses appear to be floating, as water laps at the verandas, but in the dry season towering stilts are revealed, the houses almost like wooden skyscrapers. You can hire a boat and cruise into the open water of the great lake to see a small floating village and learn some more about this incredible natural flood barrier.
- After a lunch break in a local restaurant, we explore the lost temple of Beng Mealea, the titanic of temples, a slumbering giant lost for centuries in the forests of Cambodia. It is the most accessible of Angkor's lost temples, a mirror image of Angkor Wat, but utterly consumed by the voracious appetite of nature.
- Constructed by Suryavarman II in the 12th century, the builder of Angkor Wat, the forest has run riot here and it is hard to get a sense of the monument's shape amid the daunting ruins. Return to your hotel in Siem Reap.

DAY 4: MEKONG 1 DAY - STAY OVERNIGHT IN SAIGON

- Have breakfast and check out hotel
- 8.30: Pick up at your hotel in HCMC. Depart for My Tho. Take a boat ride along the river, view the stilt houses and the fruit plantation along the river bank. Proceed to Tortoise island and have lunch in the orchard.
- Enjoy a boat ride through Tan Thach natural canal in Ben Tre, cruising under the shadow of the water coconut trees. Visit a family business which epitomizes the idyllic rural lifestyle. Enjoy a rowing boat ride along the creeks. After taking a delightful walking through the fruit plantation, village.

DAY 5: CU CHI + CITY - FLY TO HOIAN - STAY OVERNIGHT IN HOIAN

- Breakfast in hotel.
- 8.00am : Pick up in hotel
- In the morning, start a sightseeing tour to the Reunification Palace, which was the former residence of the President of South Vietnam until end of the war in April 1975, and some French colonial structures including Notre Dame Cathedral, the Old Central Post Office. Tour of Chinatown and Thien Hau & Quan Am pagodas.
- Continue visiting War Remnants Museum We end the city tour with Ben Thanh market where anything and everything is for sale. Finish your Ho Chi Minh city tours.
- Lunch in local restaurant
- Then visit Cu Chi Tunnels - 70 km from Ho Chi Minh city. Visit The tunnel of Cu Chi – a former underground military base with the unbelievable 200-km long underground complex,. Optional: shooting at the shooting range with CKC or AK gun.
- Back to hotel

DAY 6: BA NA HILLS - STAY OVERNIGHT IN HOIAN

- 08:30: Pick up guests at HOTEL, depart to Ba Na hills
- 09:30: Arrive at the cable car station Hoi An. Sitting in the cabin, in midair, looking upon the endless tree lone of the forest. Experiencing the pristine ecological system of the Ba Na mountain will leave you a sense of unforeseeable discovery.
- 10:00: Visit the Le Jardin, old wineries - remains of French Villas and Linh Ung pagoda with 27m high Buddha statue. Leave Le Jardin for Gare Debay, the second cable car station, to go to the top of Ba Na
- 10:50: Visit and play game at the Fantasy Park- Ba Na Hills Fantasy Park- the third largest indoor amusement park in the world (only some free games depending on Ba Na policy).
- 11h45: Have lunch buffet at Restaurant
- 12:45: Conquer the Peak of Chua mountain at the height of 1,487m. Enjoy the panorama view of the Da Nang from the top of Ba Na Hills. And then visit Golden Bridge.

- 14:30: Return to cable car station and transfer to Hoian
- 15:00- 15:30: Send - off guest at hotel

DAY 7: FREE AT LEISURE - STAY OVERNIGHT IN HOIAN**DAY 8: HOIAN COOKING + FARMING TRIP - FLY TO HANOI**

- 8.30 AM: Pick up at hotel lobby then go direct to Duy Nghia Harbour to depart for Duy Hai Fishing Village. You will watch the fishermen bring in their catch from a night at sea on the river delta; where ocean and river meet. Witness how locals smoke and dry the fish.
- Then spend the rest of the morning paddling the Vietnamese boat and explore the now tranquil coconut-palm flanked waterways before breaking to prepare lunch with a local family. Your lunch will consist of many local delicacies
- After lunch, ride a bicycle to a local farm in Tra Que village. Introduction to the history of the village, the cultivation of the vegetables as well as discovering about the use of vegetables in traditional Vietnamese medicine. You will take a trip around the vegetable garden
- You will be accompanied by a knowledgeable and experienced guide who will provide extensive information on the history and folklore of these villages. Take this tour for the perfect way to escape the hustle and bustle of Hoi An city center.

Next to Drive the basket boat

- Join to ride basket boat with local farmer at CO CO RIVER where you see the fishermen daily fishing

Be a farmer

- You are fascinated by watching the farming procedures of local farmers, including: raking the ground, sowing, watering, picking vegetables and many other activities which are rarely seen in modern daily life.
- You can join one of the local farmers and get a feel of what it is like to work the land. Get your hands muddy and the photo opportunities are endless. As well you will listen to people talking about organic farming techniques and try their hand at actual farming.

Make rice paper

- Have eaten fresh Vietnamese spring rolls? Rice paper is what it used to wrap the rolls. If you are interested in the process of rice paper making – rice grinding, boiling, stretching and drying – then there is a workshop just for you.
- Back to hotel after your wonderful day

DAY 9: CITY TOUR - TRAIN TO SAPA

- 9.00am : Pick up in your hotel

- Starting trip of visiting the most beautiful places in Hanoi including Ho Chi Minh complex: Ho Chi Minh mausoleum, Ho Chi Minh Still House/ Garden/ Fish Lake to explore the life of the most Vietnamese famous person also about Vietnam history
- Have lunch in local restaurant. Keep continuing to see the best scenery of country side with motorbike by passing Long Bien Bridge, Red River, Famers, Vegertable Farms. Seeing how the local Vietnamses living in quite town
- Heading to The West Lake which is the biggest lake in Hanoi before back to Old quarter for Street Foods. Walking pass most beautiful and colourful streets, (Night market on every Fri - Sun)to Dong Xuan Market,walking around Hoan Kiem Lake to visit and enjoy local street foods).
- Will stop in the best restaurants on street to have the most delicious and interesting foods in Hanoi. This special tour is not only about eating and tasting foods which is more special from Funny Travel to bring to you a full view of Vietnam colourful cultures and long history by passing to Hanoi French quarter .
- Continue your nightlife street food walking tour by visiting international Beer corner to drink local Bia Hoi which is the best beer in Hanoi. The street foods will be serving : Bun Cha, Pho, Nem(spring roll), Sticky rice cake, Local beer (fresh beer), egg coffe, mix fruits and milk
- Rest till evening to take an overnight train to Sapa

DAY 10: SAPA TREKKING – STAY IN HOTEL IN SAPA

- Early morning: Arrive in Lao Cai station. Our guide will pick you up at station and transfer to Sapa town.
- Leave your luggages at the hotel and have breakfast.
- 9.00am: Start the tour to Cat Cat village. trekking down to the village and you will be impressed by the peacefully picturesque sceneries. Visitors can easily catch sight of women sitting in front of their houses with colorful handmade products, and the children playing surrounding. This is an opportunity to understand more about ethnic people’s life and customs as well
- 12.00: Have lunch in local restaurant with traditional food. Then, relax for a while
- 14.00: Continue the trip by trekking further to see more stunning landscapes of Sin chai village + and impressive your self with Sapa heaven gate which is the highest stretch of road in Vietnam as well as the provincial border of Lao Cai and Lai Chau provinces. Enjoy fantastic view over the valley!
- 16.00: Back to hotel.
- Free at night in Sapa town. Walking around the night market and shopping.

DAY 11: BAC HA MARKET – STAY IN HOMESTAY IN SAPA

- 6.30 AM - Having breakfast
- 7:30 AM – Check out and depart to Bac Ha Market.

- 11.00 AM – Arrive at Bac Ha Market
- Free time for visiting one of the most colourful market in the world. This big market in North West Vietnam filled with many different hill-tribe peoples such as Flower H`mong, Dzay, Tay people, ... At the market, you have chance to enjoy Bac Ha people`s simple but unique kinds of food with special wines made from rice, cassavas, corn and different sorts of fruits such as plumps, apples, peaches, ... talking to the minorities through the guides interpretation.
- After lunch, leave the market for visiting the H`mong Kings House (King Hoang A Tuong) built by French colonists and the Chinese in 1920, short walking to see Ban Pho village where is homeland of Flower Hmong.
- Back to Sapa and stay in homestay

DAY 12: SA PA VILLAGES – TAKE A LIMOUSINE TO HANOI – STAY IN HANOI

7.00: Have breakfast and check out hotel

8.00: Enjoy the morning in Sapa. Transfer to Y Linh Ho, start trekking passing the rice fields and Muong Hoa stream to reach to Lao Chai village – house of Black H`mong people

On the high point of the road, great view of the whole villages open wide to offer a marvelous panorama view. Here you will enjoy the fresh air, see terraced fields and stream, discover tradition and custom of ethnic people in this area

12.00: Check in homestay and have lunch with local family

15:00: Take a limousine back to Hanoi

DAY 13: NINH BINH 1 DAY – STAY IN NINH BINH

- 8.00: Have breakfast then get picked up to Ninh Binh
- 9.30am : Arrive and visit Hoa Lu - the first capital of Vietnam, see the temple where we worship our King. Listen to the story about Vietnamese history.
- 11.00: Have lunch in local restaurant
- 13.00: Get on the sampan boat to do the trip along the river. Enjoy peaceful and picturesque landscapes of Tam Coc river. And you will understand why it considered as Halong Bay on Land.
- 15.00: Time for cycling around the villages
- 17.00: Back to the resort and relax

DAY 14: NINH BINH – HALONG – STAY ON CRUISE

- 7.30am: Go straight from Tam Coc to Halong bay. We will drop you off at Tuan Chau island around 11.00AM – 11.30AM. Check in the cruise when tour starts
- 11:30 : Arrive at Scarlet Pearl Cruise's Lounge in Halong International Cruise Port to check-in. Guests will be offered “welcome drink” and listen to instructions before boarding.
- 12:00 Guests will start boarding.

- 13:00 A splendid lunch is served at Tahiti Restaurant while the cruise travelling across primitive Lan Ha Bay. The bay has hundreds of islands and islets, making it a wonderful background for guests to look at while dining.
- 15:00 : Arrive at Sang Cave by kayaking or rowing boat as the path towards the cave is 70m long of water. On the way, guests will be amazed by sparkling karst arcs through sunlight. Afterwards, guests are invited to enter Ech Lagoon, an extremely serene and emerald spot to kayak and swim. It'll be a wonderful chance to immerse in one of the most remote parts of Lan Ha Bay. The shape of this lagoon looks like a giant frog resting, hence it explains the name “Ao Éch” in Vietnamese.
- 17:00 : Return to the cruise to relax and admire the sunset on the sundeck.
- 17:30 : Watching sunset over Lan Hạy Bay is one of the moments that shouldn't be missed out. During this time, there will be either a Sunset Party in Sky Bar or a cooking class hosted by our Chef (depending on the season).
- From 17:30-18:30 : it is Happy Hour meaning Buy One Get One Free - this promotion is applied on our limited drinks menu. Guests can also choose to watch the sunset by catamaran while sipping fresh cocktails (this is surcharged).
- 19:00 : Fine-dining dinner will be started along with fun and interactive cultural exchange between all the guests and our Vietnamese host.

DAY 15: HALONG – DEPART

- 06:30 : Begin a new day with a Tai Chi session while welcoming magnificent sunrise. (Guests can also choose to take photos and enjoy the scene if they prefer so.) A light breakfast is served from.
- 06:45-07:30 : in the refreshing and peaceful beauty of the Bay.
- 07:30 Explore Lan Ha Bay by catamaran to more remote destinations that larger cruises cannot reach.
- 09:00 Get ready to check out.
- 09:30 Guests will be served with succulent buffet brunch in Tahiti Restaurant before disembarking.
- 11:00 - 11:30 The cruise is now back at the Port.
- 12:10-12:30: Now you can board the van and go straight to the airport. Depart
