14.00: Continue the trip by trekking further to see more stunning landscapes of Sin chai village + and impressive your self with Sapa heaven gate which is the highest stretch of road in Vietnam as well as the provincial border of Lao Cai and Lai Chau provinces. 16.00: Back to hotel.

Free at night in Sapa town. Walking around the night market and shopping.

Day 2: Trekking Lao Chai – Ta Van – Overnight in homestay (Meals: B,L,D)

17.00: Back to homestay and prepare dinner with the family

Day 3: Sapa Waterfalls – bus back to Hanoi (Meals:B,L)
